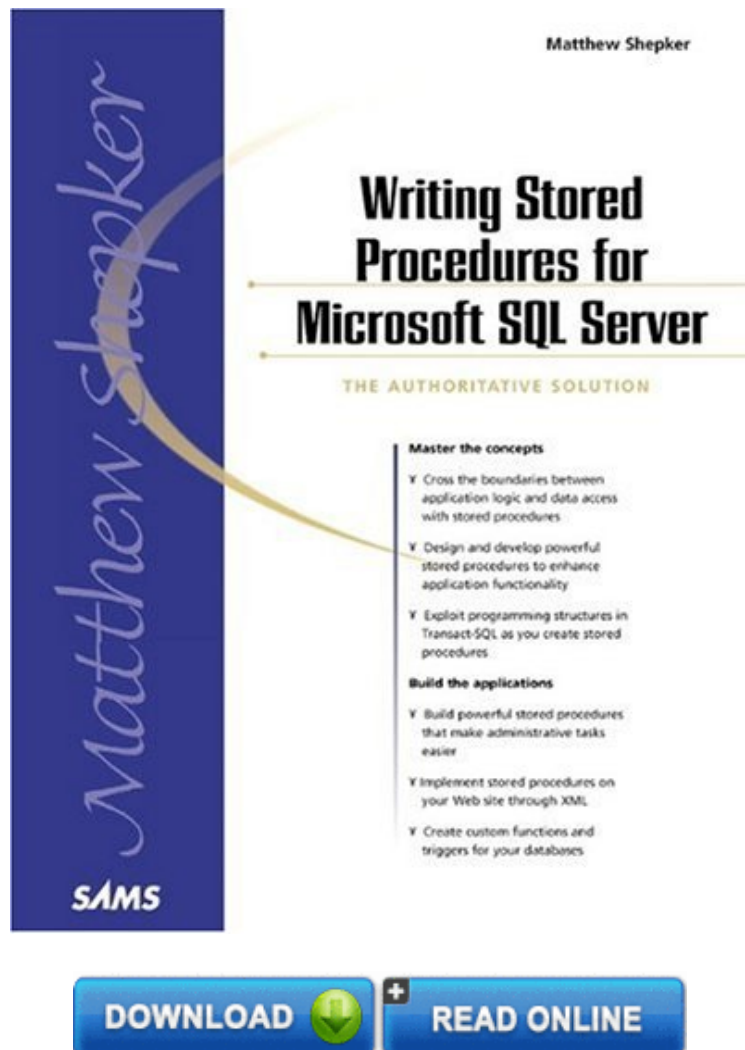

I was surprised to find a chapter on the fact that MS SQL Server 2000 is offering XML support probably out of ignorance. Unfortunately, for those who wish to write stored procedures, once you get past the ways XML and SQL work together to pass parameters and query data you are given almost an entire chapter on XML basics and how to construct XML documents. It appears Microsoft is making up for lost chapters in more appropriate books here. Luckily, I just happened to be learning XML at the same time so I had some interest in this chapter. It actually

explains some basic XML issues better than the XML books themselves although it is only a limited chapter in a stored procedure book. The author kind of left the topic of XML and SQL Server 2000 working together and decided to discuss basic XML. Other than that and the fact that few if any books/chapters have ever mentioned the fact you can create your sp and triggers within the Enterprise Manager environment, this is a pretty good way to learn stored procedures if you have never done them before.
